The C-Club consisted of 20 boys who earned letters in the athletic sports of the school. It is an organization formed to extend and improve athletics within our high school.

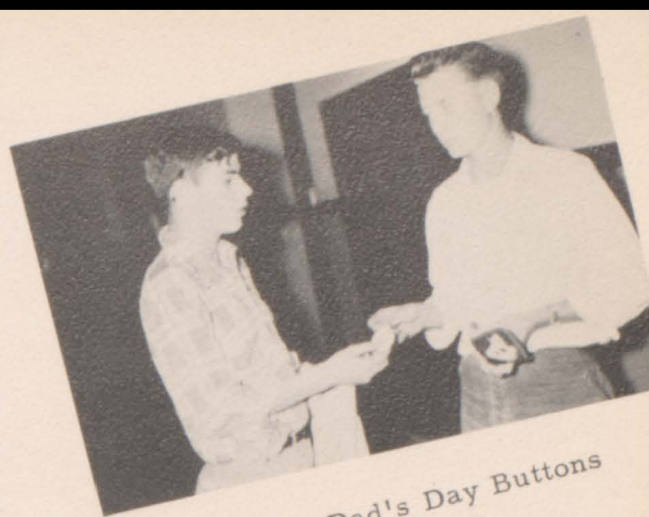
Its greatest accomplishment the past year was the purchasing of 22 white helmets for the football squad.

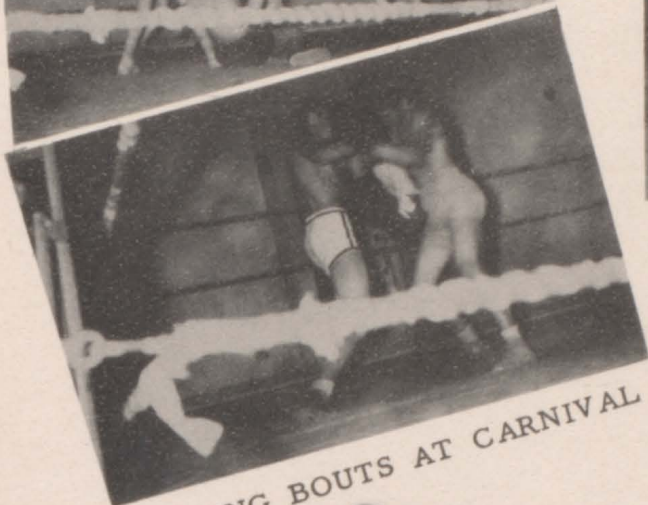
At the start of the 1950-51 school year, 65 boys expressed a desire to be members of the Hi-Y.

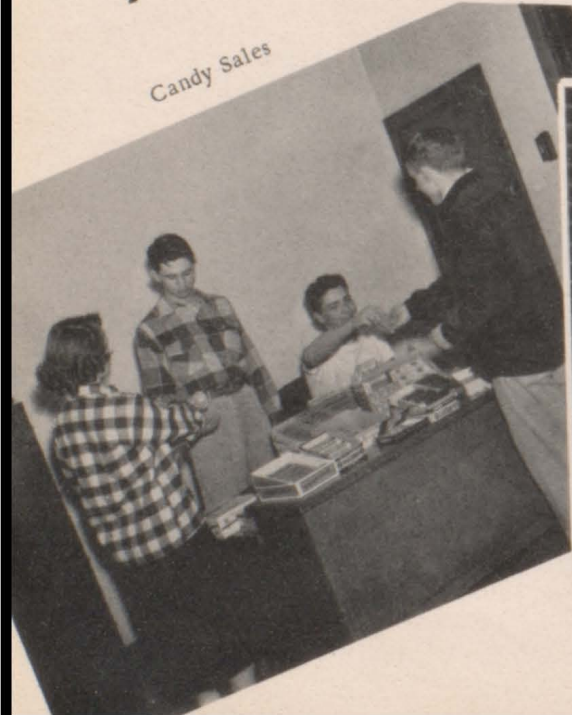
