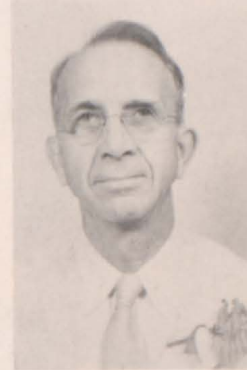

To the seniors it will mean either college or going to work and in some instances serving Uncle Sam.

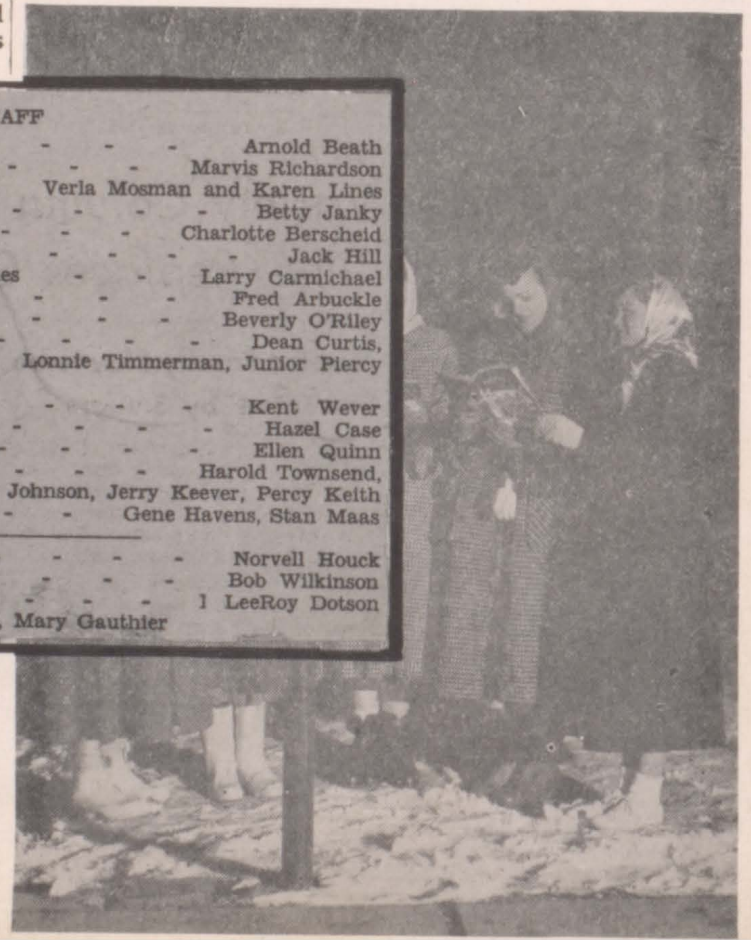
