Senko's father is a teachers' counselor; her mother is a teacher; her elder sister is a Junior at Tokyo University of Education at Tokyo, and her younger sister is in the ninth grade at Kanoiwa Junior High School.

This year Senko is taking English 12, Literature for Today, American Problems, Speech first semester, and Personal Typing second semester. She also Participates in Girls' Glee, is an honorary member of the Student Council, is a Y-Teen. She was a member of Japanese Literature Club and English Club in Kofu High School.

The following paragraphs were written by Senko for our Red Raider:

"When I began to study English, I was so interested and about six years ago, I knew American Field Service. Although there is a high school close to my home, I went to the bigger and better high school to have a chance to study English much harder in order to pass the AFS test. When I was a sophomore, I took AFS test but I failed. Since then I studied only English--reading, writing, conversation, etc. My desire to come to America was strong and unchangeable.

"When I was in Junior, I took the test again. After taking four tests, one at the school, one at the office in a prefecture, one at Nagoya, and the last one at Tokyo, I could pass at last. I was so glad and decided to study in the USA.

"I want to be a teacher of English in Japan. Because Japanese should learn foreign language since Japanese is not a common language in the world. I think Japanese should learn English because English is common in the world. And I believe understanding between the people never be accomplished without the help of language. To understand we must learn language. And to teach language to the children in Japan, at first I must learn. That's the main reason why I desired to come to America and am trying to understand now."
