"This past summer I went to Lima, Peru, on the American Field Service Program. I arrived there on June 21st and left August 27th.

"My host family's name was Gamba and consisted of Mama, Papa, Carlos, age 17, and Virginia, age 12, nicknamed "Poppi." They were all born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and have also lived in La Paz, Bolivia. They all spoke English and Spanish fluently. My Papa held three jobs: A public accountant for the government, one running his own consulting firm, and one teaching at a university causing him to be gone a good deal. During the week, my Mama would teach the Indians who lived in a "barreada" (Spanish for slums) called "Ciudad de Dios" (City of God) how to make nourishing meals from the foodstuffs they received through the Food for Peace Program.

"My brother and sister attended St. Margarita school. The school day lasted from 8:30 to 4:30 -- with a three hour lunch and "siesta" break. Total enrollment in the school was about 300. The kids all spoke good English. Their subjects ranged from English and French to Peruvian history and psychology. Sports such as volleyball and soccer were organized to some extent.

"Lima, the capital of Peru, with over two million inhabitants is rather modern in newer sections and very Spanish in the older ones. The Andes can be seen from downtown on a clear winter day. The average temperature year-round is about 65°F. Winter differs from summer in that a thick cloud layer covers the coast daily."

"I was born in April 2, 1946. My parents are gardeners and farmers. They grow fruit trees in their garden and they grow rice in their farm.

"I have 4 brothers and 4 sisters, I have only one younger brother, he is 14 years old and I am 19 years old, all of us are Buddhist.

"When I was 5 years old, I went to live with my sister and my brother-in-law who is a teacher, they live in the southern part of Thailand. I began to study when I was 7 years old, I studied in elementary school for 4 years, 6 years in secondary school. When I finished my education from secondary school, I would like to be a teacher in future so I went to study in Girls' Teacher Training School. All students in that school are girls. I must study for 2 years in Girls' Teacher Training School.

"When I was studying in the first year of the school, my teacher told me about A. F. S. program but I was not interest in it because I never thought to come to the United States, I wanted to come to U. S. when I was in the last year of the school. I wanted to come to U. S. because I thought about the subject that I wanted to teach in future. I liked English so I would like to teach English.

"When I found the subject that I wanted to teach, I thought to find the way to study about the subject, I was looking for scholarship to come to U. S. to study English. There is one scholarship for my age that is A. F. S., so I decided to be an A. F. S. student and I knew that I could come to U. S. when it was the last term of my school.

"I come to U. S. this time, not only I wanted to study English but I wanted to bring an understanding between my country and U. S. too.

"Now I am a student in Teacher College, I have been in Teacher College for 2 months before I came here and when I go back to my country I have 2 more years in Teacher College."
