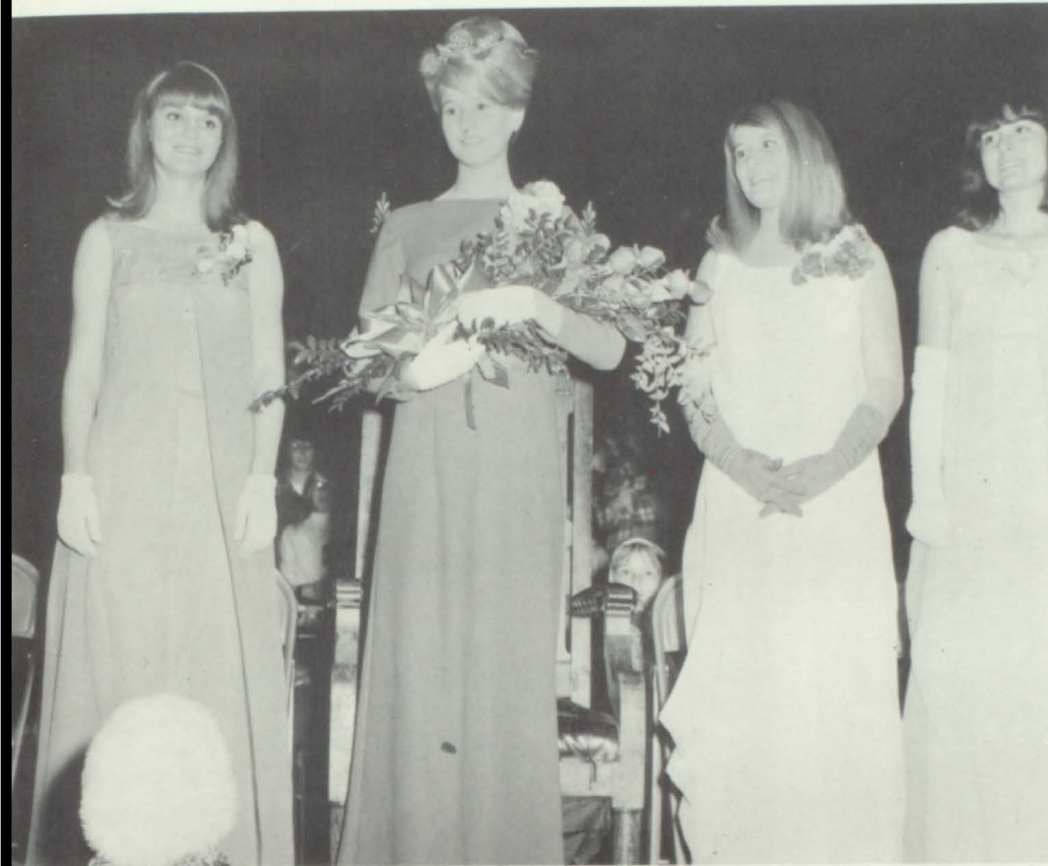

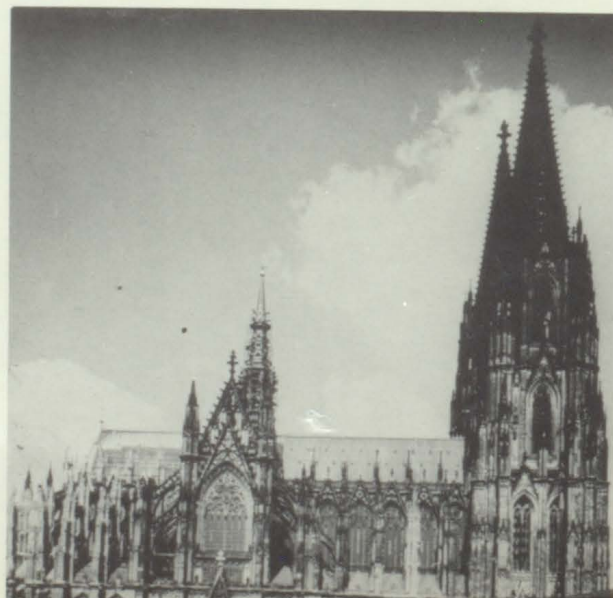
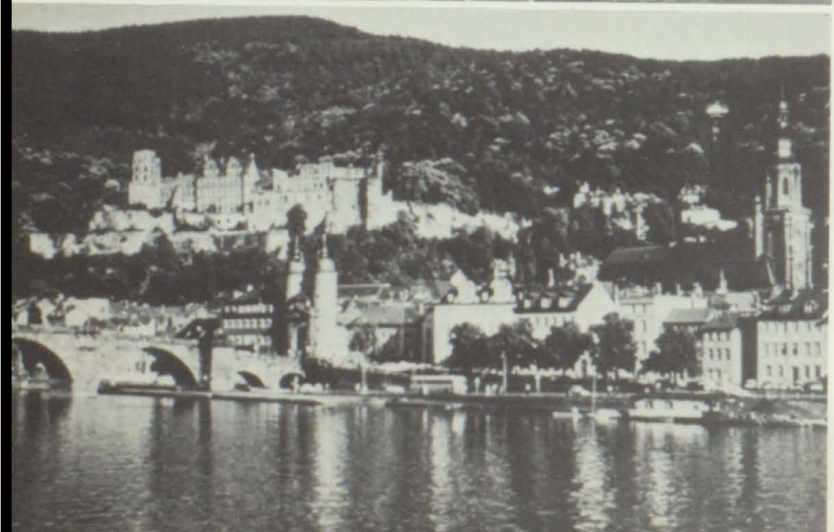
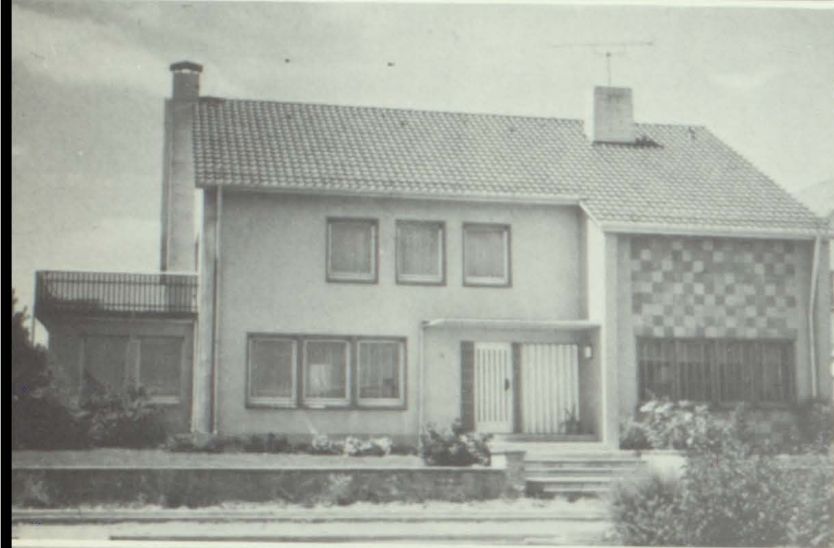
Tom Crawford, A.F.S. Exchange Student to Germany

This past summer I went to Bohmte, Germany, a little town of 6,000 inhabitants halfway between Hamburg and Cologne, on the American Field Service Program. I sailed from New York Harbor on the S.S. Ryndam on June 21st and landed at Rotterdam, Holland, July 1st. I flew home August 30th.

My host family's name was Engelhardt and consisted of Mutti (my mother), Papa, Georg, and Karl Wilhelm (both 22), Peter (age 17) who is now in Cleveland, Ohio on the A.F.S. program; and Dorlien (age 16). My parents didn't speak English, but my brothers and sister spoke English very well and often acted as my interpreter. My Papa was a retired wholesale egg dealer, and my Mutti was a housewife.

It was summer vacation most of the time I was in Europe. An average morning started at nine with breakfast. Then one of my brothers or my sister and I would work in the garden picking berries, weeding, etc. until dinner. Our main meal consisted of delicious breads and mounds of potatoes but little meats. In the afternoon we often went sailing in one of our two boats on a nearby lake or went swimming.

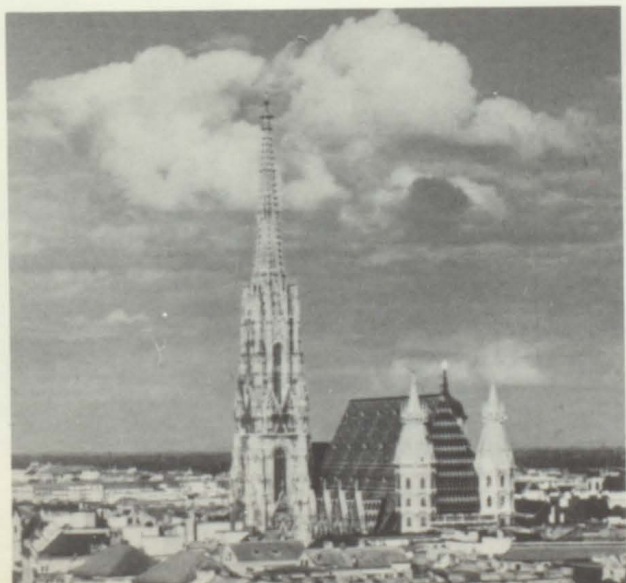
Having finished four years of elementary school I went on to high school, which I attended for eight years and finished last June.

After my return to Austria, I want to work in the field of business in which I intended to stay; but I changed my mind. Now my ambition is to become an airline stewardess. My A.F.S.-year in Corning gave me the rich experience not only of learning the English language better, but also of getting acquainted with many people and getting to know their way of living. 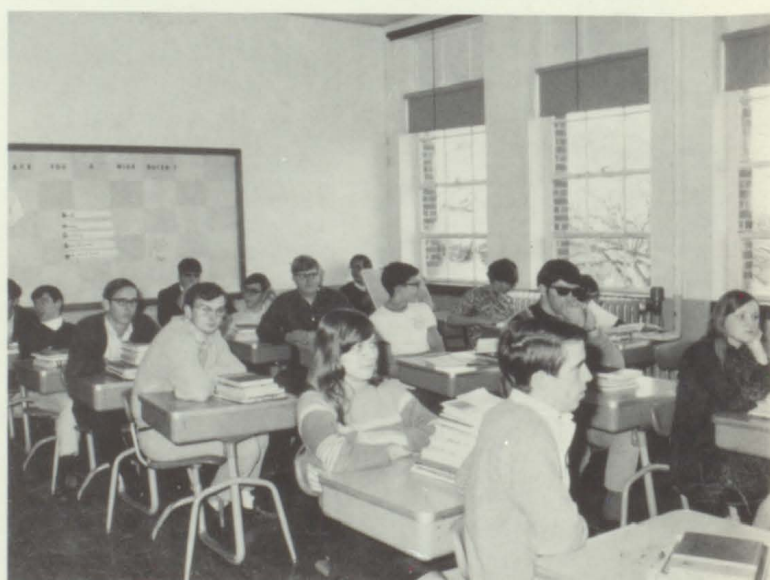

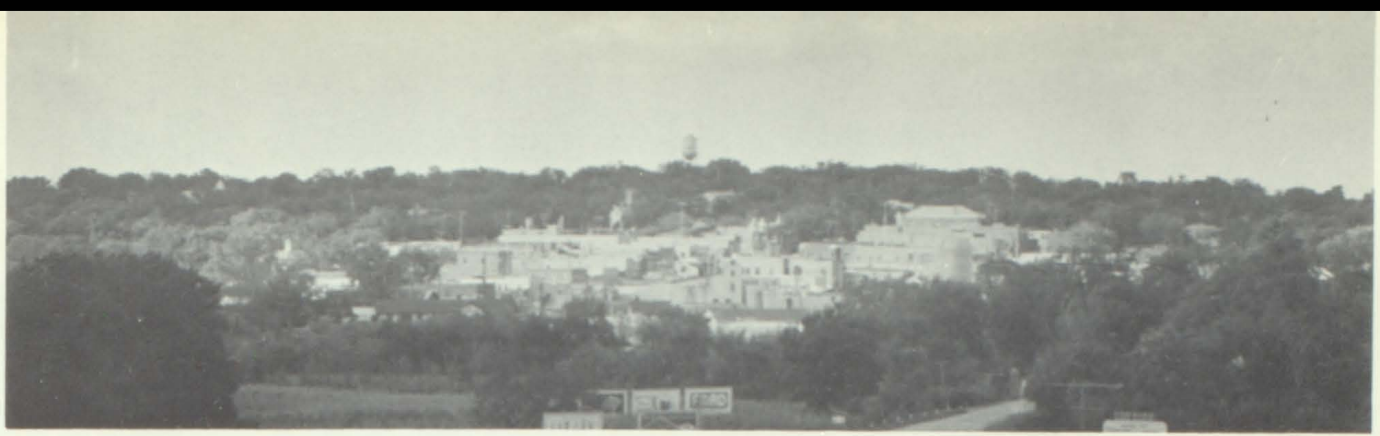

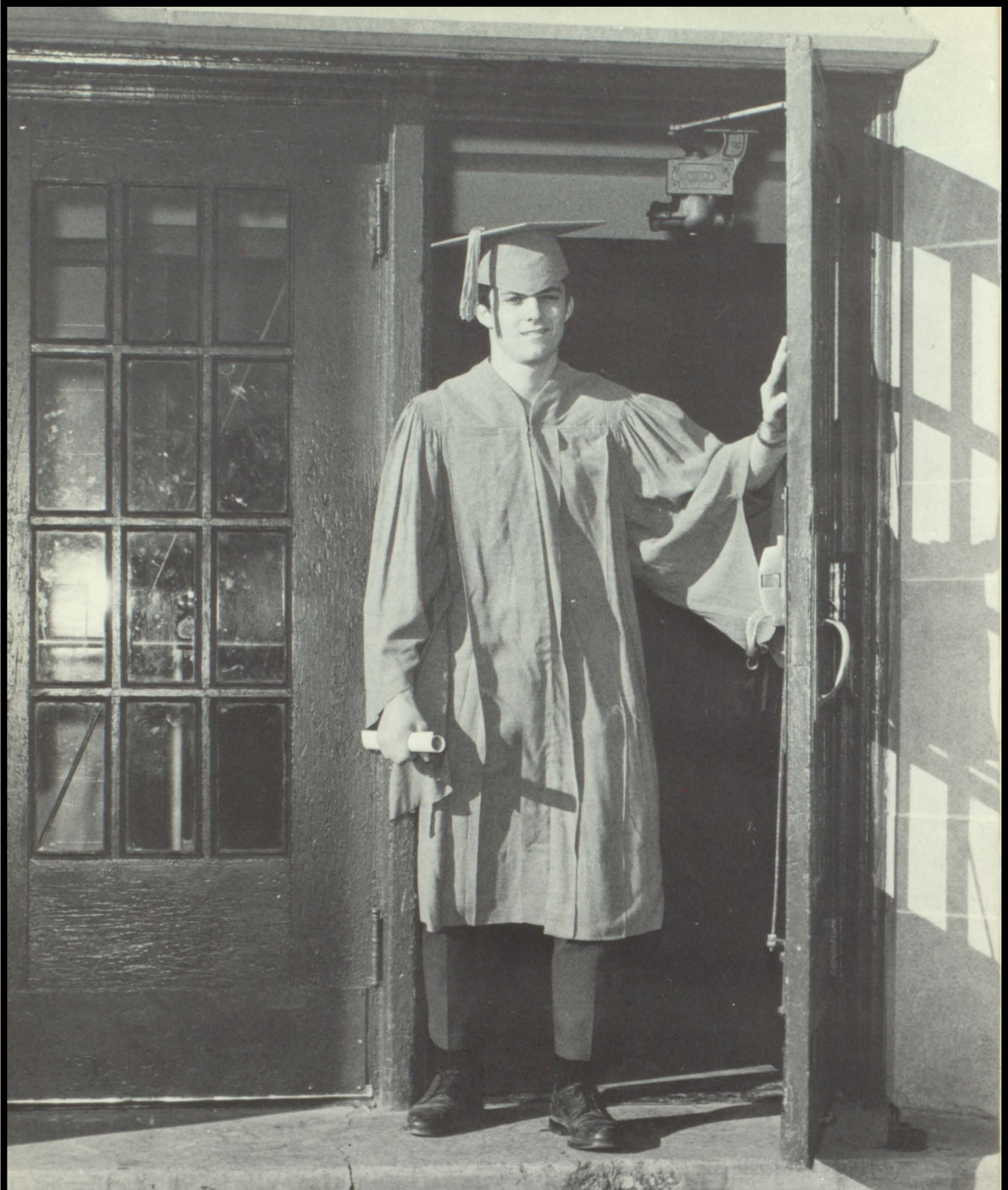
