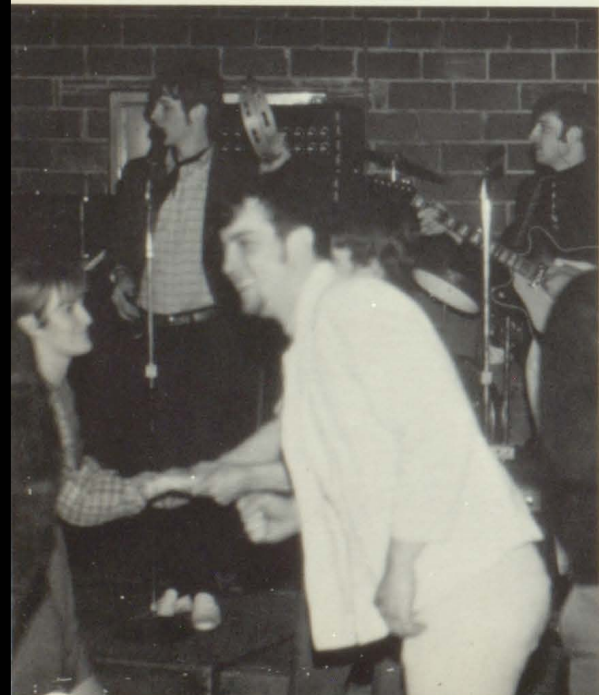

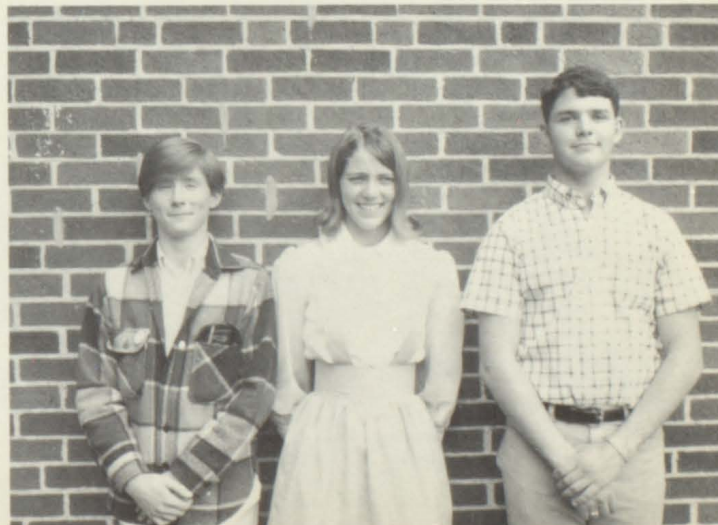

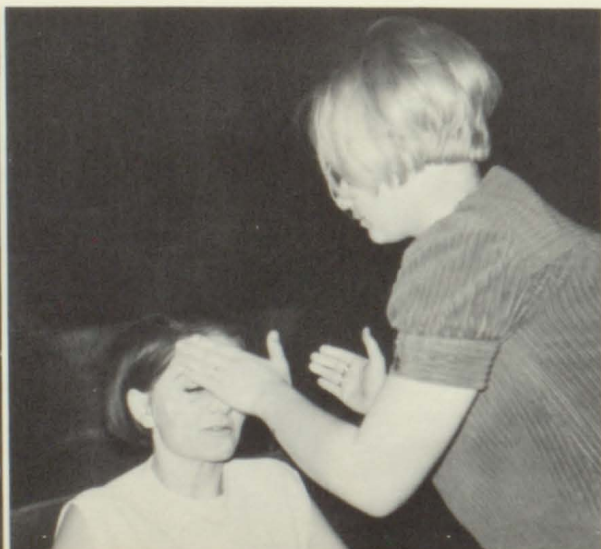

I finished high school in Denmark so this was my second graduation. When I go back home, I plan to study to be a veterinary-nurse in Copenhagen.

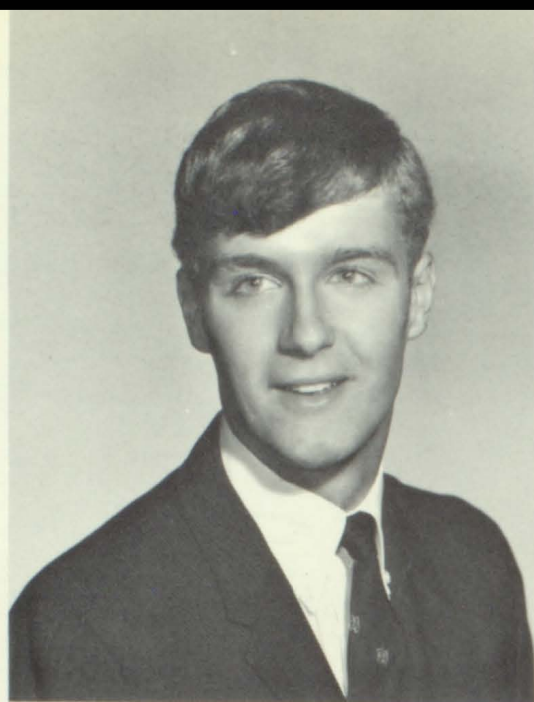
