I am from Piura, in Northwest Peru. Piura has about 40,000 people. Peru has 12,772,000 people and is 496,224 sq. miles.

My country is divided into Departments. The Department is divided into Provinces. The province is divided into districts, like yours: Country into States, State into Countries, County into Townships. My country also is divided into three zones: Coast, Mountains, and Forest. Every zone has different costumes.

My parents have five sons and five daughters. I am the fifth. I'll be seventeen on March 31, 1970.

I learned about the AFS Program from a classmate. We applied at the same time. Now she has a scholarship too. She is in New York.

When I learned that I had gotten the scholarship, I was in the fourth month of school, and I asked the Director of Schools if I could be absent for one year. They accepted it, so when I go back I'll go to school for five months more.

My school is an all girls Catholic school taught by nuns. In my school we have a different schedule. We go to school at 7:45 a.m. and come home at 12:00 a.m. Every class is 45 minutes long. Then we go back to school from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. We have twenty minutes in the morning and twenty minutes in the afternoon for recreation.

I arrived in Miami on August 18, 1969, and in Corning on August 22.

I am very thankful to everyone who made it possible for me to come here.





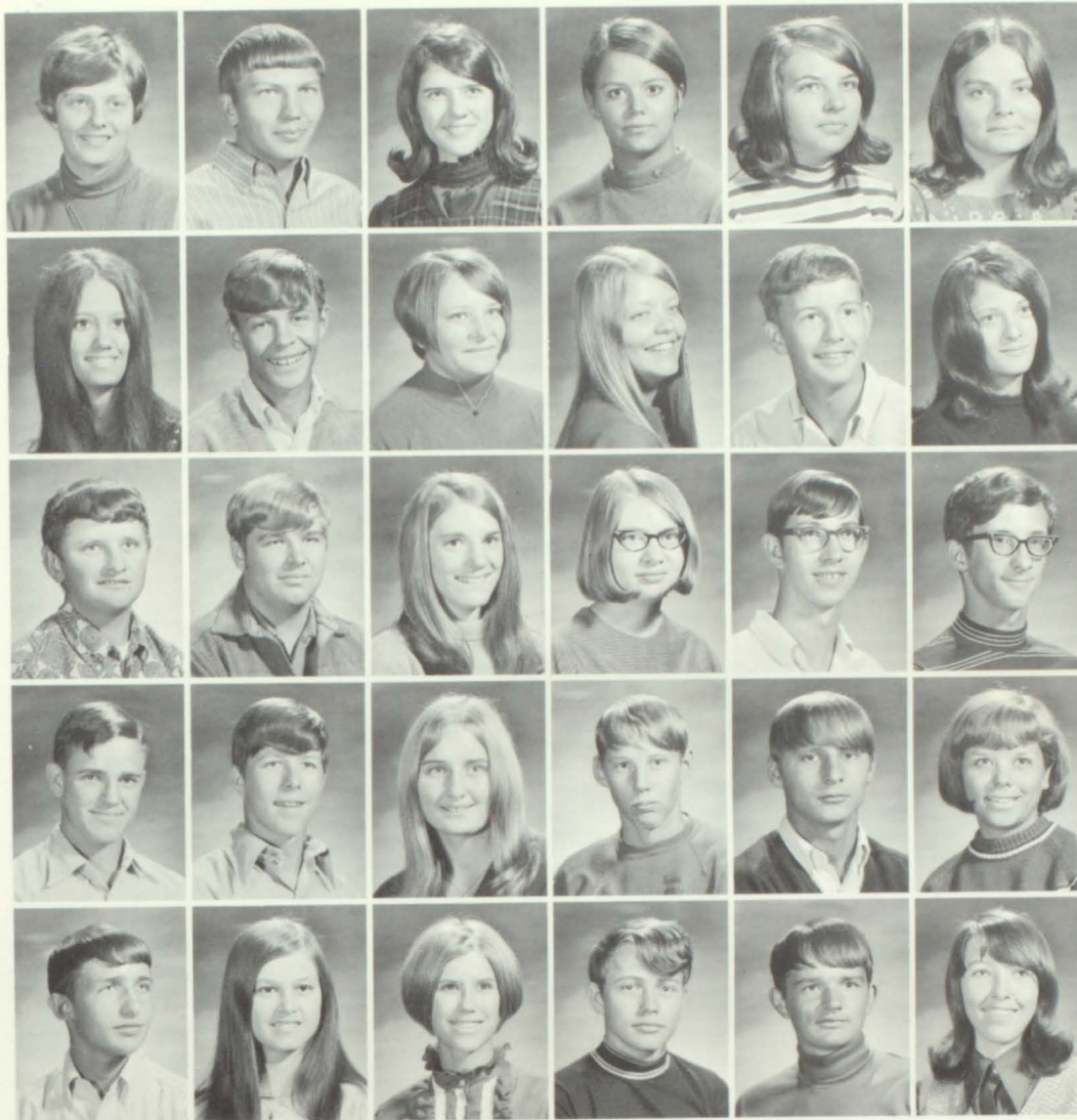
