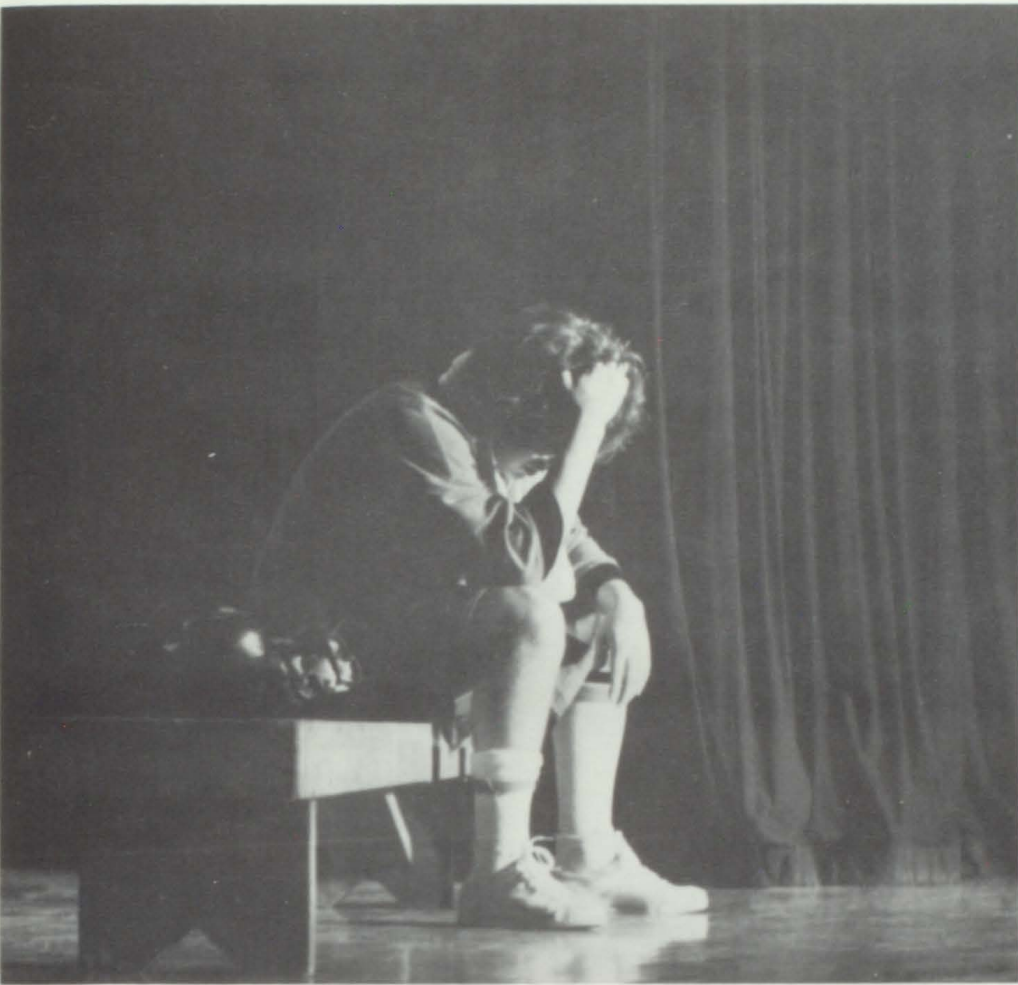

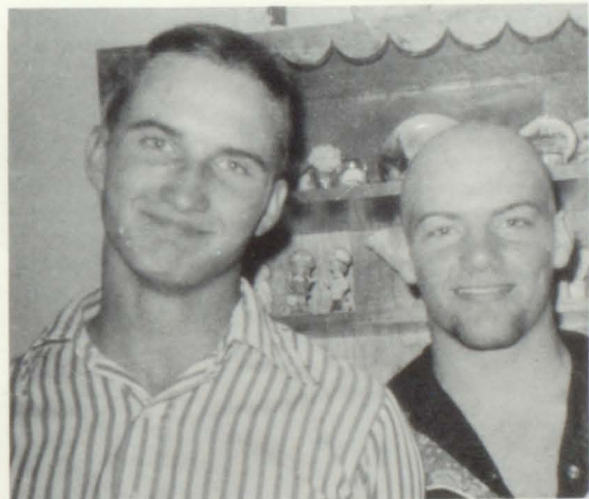

Corning High School is proud and grateful to have Mr. John Lenz on its staff, and in the Corning community. Thank you, Mr. Lenz!

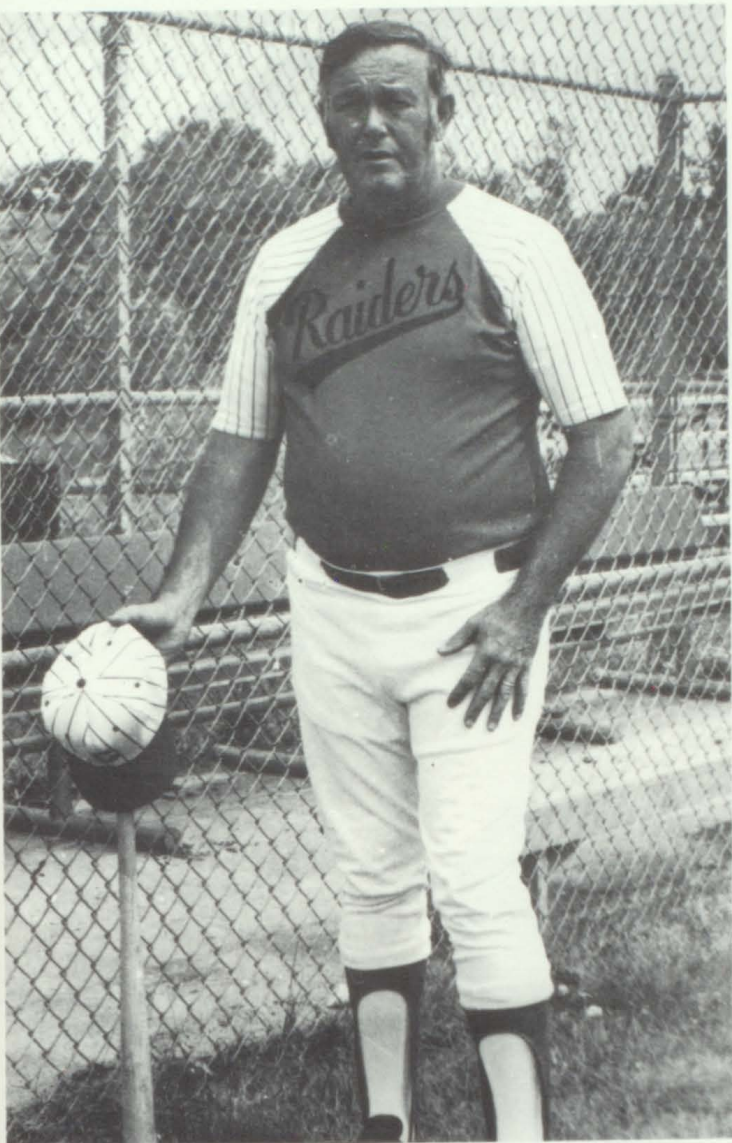

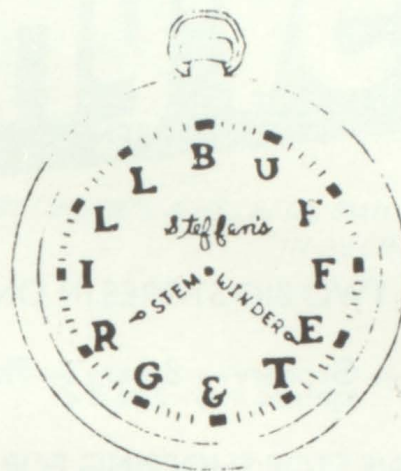
