The National Honor Society was formed by the National Association of Secondary School Principals in 1921. Corning has had its Charter since 1938 and has had membership every year since then. The Corning High School faculty, by electing candidates for membership, honors their attainments and recognizes the promises they offer of excellence.

The emblem of this society is the keystone and the flaming torch. The keystone bears at its base the letters S, L, C, and S which stands for the cardinal principles of the organization; scholarship, leadership, character and service. As the keystone is placed by a builder to hold the arch in place so the structure of our education must be held firm and true by the virtues represented in this symbol.

The flaming torch is symbolical of our purpose to carry forward the searching light of truth, to lead, that others may follow the light, to keep burning in our school a high ambition for the enduring values of life, and to serve with unselfish loyalty to truth and honor.

To become a candidate and eventually a member of the National Honor Society at Corning High School, the first requirement is to be in the upper one-third of the class. The faculty then in secret ballot recommends students based on Leadership, Character and Service to school and community. No more than fifteen per cent of a class may be chosen.

This is considered the highest award bestowed upon Corning High School students by the Corning High School Faculty.

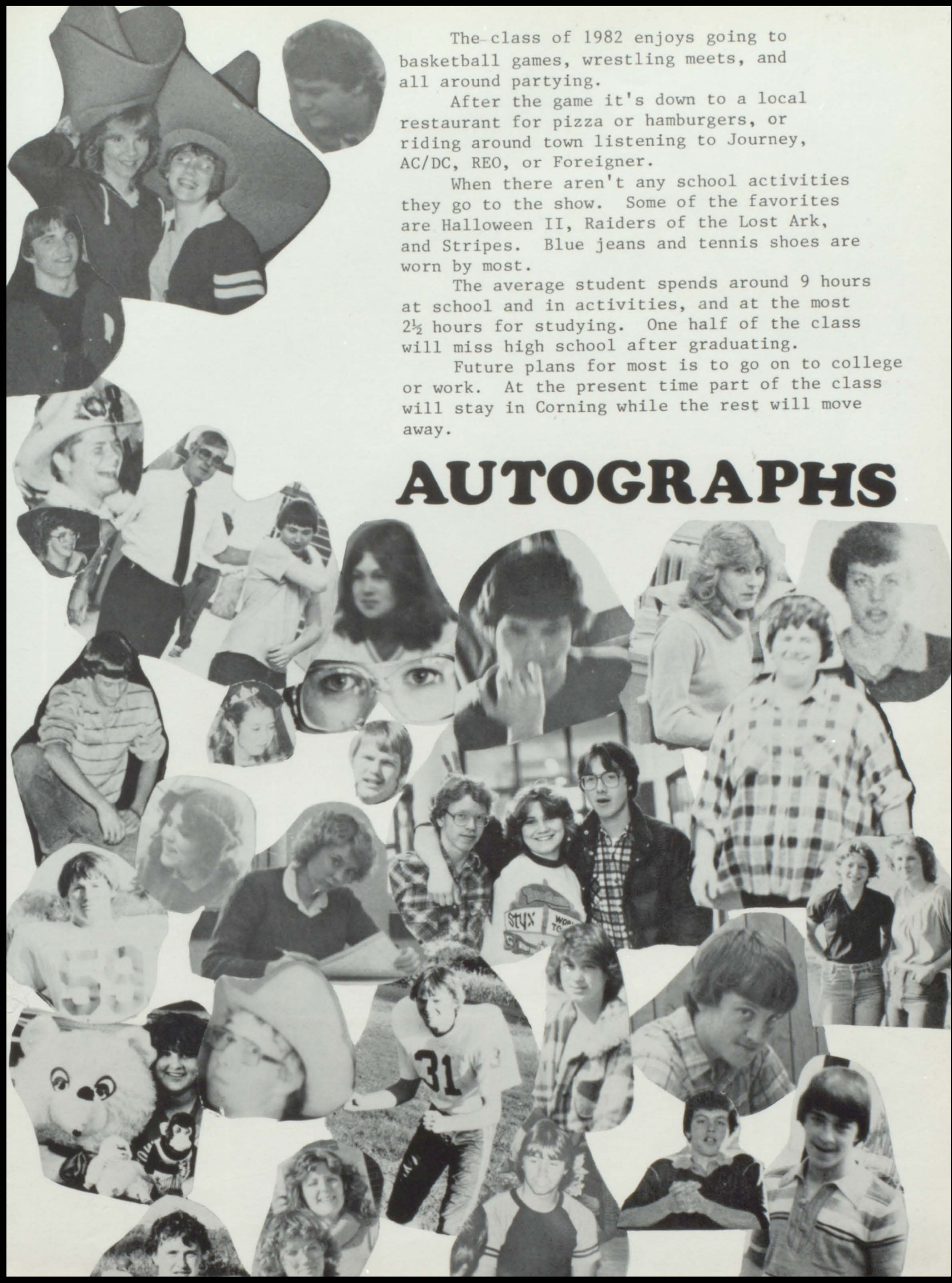
After the game it's down to a local restaurant for pizza or hamburgers, or riding around town listening to Journey, AC/DC, REO, or Foreigner.

Future plans for most is to go on to college or work. At the present time part of the class will stay in Corning while the rest will move away.

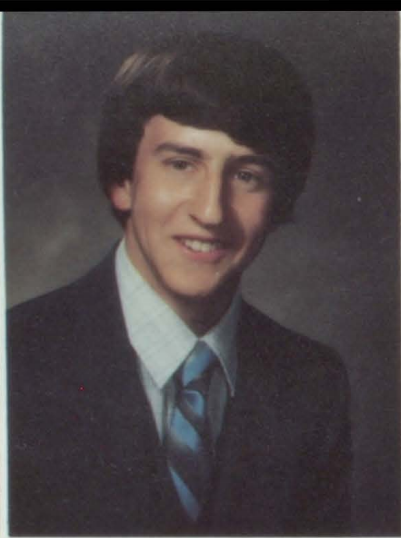

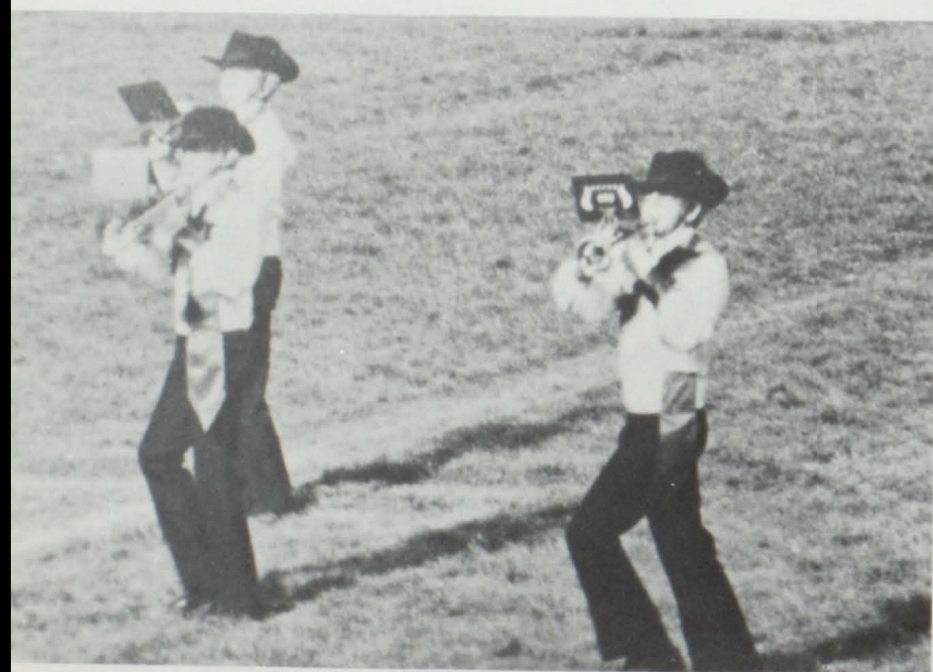
